Do you have trouble making it to the bank? Give mobile banking a try!

We often hear how difficult making it to the bank can be. Sometimes your bike gets a flat, other times you really need to use your time to study for a test. These things happen, but they don't have to keep you from making your monthly deposit. Here are some helpful tips to get started with mobile banking:

- Check out your bank's info and apps:
 - Alliance Bank
 - Hughes Federal Credit Union
 - Vantage West
- Download the app
- Make your next deposit using the app or transfer it through the online bank site
- Double-check your online account to make sure the deposit went through
- And of course, be sure to do this before the 15th when your deposit is due

You can also just Google your bank's name and "mobile banking" or "mobile deposit" to learn more. You will save tons of time cutting out the travel time to the bank! Yeah for saving both time and money!
